With regular developmental checks and progress reports.

How we adapt the learning environment and ensure that our school facilities are safe and welcoming to children with SEND

By accessing relevant equipment and liaising with the medical professionals who can assist.

How we include children with SEND in the life of our setting

By promoting diversity and inclusion in my setting.

How we ensure that all our staff are trained and supported to meet a wide range of children's needs

By accessing up to date training programmes.

External support and expertise we can call upon to help us to meet children's need

EY, Social services, DR's, GP's, Nurses, Health Visitors and parent as well as a schools.

With reassurance and help from parents.

How we prepare children to move on from our setting

As above, and encouragement and support.
